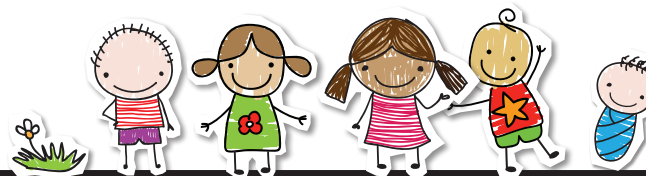

## 4 Year old preschool vaccination

Victorian legislation requires that children have an Immunisation History Statement before entering school. Children are due at 4 years for their preschool vaccination. Council provides show bags for 4 year olds at all evening immunisation sessions listed on this program. Once your child has received their 4 year old immunisation, an immunisation history statement will be forwarded to your home address from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR). This history statement is required by school when enrolling your child.

<b>4 years</b>	<b>InfanrixIPV</b>	diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough & Inactivated Polio
<b>6 months to 5 years</b>	<b>Influenza</b>

## Hobsons bay city council immunisation service information

### Attending an immunisation session (No appointments necessary)

- you should attend a session at least half an hour before the session finishes, as there is a 15 minute observation period after any vaccinations are given.
- on arrival at a session, take a number and wait to be called.
- always read the pre-immunisation checklist and inform the nurse of any concerns prior to vaccination.

### Infant vaccinations

- babies can be vaccinated from 6 weeks of age, no earlier.
- bring the Child Health Record or any other immunisation history for your child. If this is baby's first immunisation, please complete the pink consent card contained in the "New Parent Immunisation Pack" and bring it with you to the session.

### Secondary School immunisation

If your child has missed their immunisation at school—it's not too late. All Council public sessions have the secondary school vaccinations available for catch-up.

### Flu Vaccinations

Flu vaccines are available at all Council sessions from May to July each year. The vaccine is free if you are over 65 years of age or at medical risk and for children 6 months to 5 years of age. The flu vaccine can be purchased at council sessions.

## Overseas/incomplete immunisation history

If for some reason your child's immunisation records are incomplete, missing, your child has never been vaccinated or has received immunisations overseas, contact Council's Immunisation Service and we will assist you in recording the history onto the AIR and providing an Immunisation History Statement for your child.

**Remember to notify Medicare Australia if you change your residential address.**
